

## INTRODUCTION TO THE MAIN CHARACTERS

### SCRIPT

0:00 - 0:51

ADAM: Hello. My name's Adam. I'm 17 and I live in London with my mother and father and my sister, Lucy. I'm at sixth form college, but in my spare time I enjoy swimming, playing tennis and cricket and spending time with my girlfriend, Sarah. This year I'm going to work at a summer camp in America.

CHRIS: Hi. I'm Chris. I'm 17 and I'm from Manchester.

LUCY: Hello. My name's Lucy. I'm Adam's younger sister. I'm 15 and I go to school in London.

ED: Hi. I'm Ed. I'm in the same class as Lucy at school.

SARAH: Hello. I'm Sarah, Adam's girlfriend. I'm 17 and I go to sixth form college in London.

MICHAEL: Hi. I'm Michael. I'm 19 years old and I'm American. I live in Boston with my parents.

KIM: Hi there. I'm Kim and I'm American too. I'm 17 years old and I live near Michael in Boston.

### EPISODE 1

#### SCRIPT

Scene 1

1:28 - 3:01

In Scene 1 we see Chris arriving at Adam's sixth form college. He finds Adam in the college café. As this is the first time they meet, both of them have got a Camp America card so that they can identify each other.

CHRIS: Are you Adam Scott?

ADAM: That's right.

CHRIS: I'm Chris Taylor. I'm doing Camp America with you.

ADAM: Hi, Chris! Nice to meet you. Welcome to London. How was your journey down from Manchester?

CHRIS: Fine. I'm just really excited about our trip to the States.

ADAM: Me too. Camp America sounds great.

CHRIS: We must send Michael that e-mail letting him know when we arrive in Boston.

ADAM: There's plenty of time for that. We don't leave until Thursday.

CHRIS: No, it's ..., it's Tuesday.

ADAM: Tuesday! That's tomorrow! Are you sure?

CHRIS: Yeah, we leave in the morning. Look! You are ready to go, aren't you?

ADAM: Yeah, no problem. Oh, no ... Tomorrow's Sarah's birthday.

CHRIS: Who's Sarah?

ADAM: My girlfriend. It's her eighteenth.

CHRIS: Oh, right.

ADAM: Why am I so stupid?

CHRIS: Anybody can make a mistake. Don't worry about it.

ADAM: You don't know Sarah.

CHRIS: Let's go and send that e-mail.

ADAM: Good idea. We can do it from the café where Sarah works.

CHRIS: OK.

Scene 2

We see Ed and Lucy in the Surf.net Café. They are surfing on the Internet.

3:01 - 4:35

ADAM: There's my 'little sister'.

CHRIS: Where?

ADAM: Over there, in the corner by the window.

CHRIS: The girl in the blue and white striped T-shirt?

ADAM: Yeah. Come on. Let's go and say hello.

LUCY: Hi.

ADAM: Lucy, this is Chris. He's doing Camp America with me.

LUCY: Oh, right.

ADAM: And this is 'Edward'.

ED: Thanks! Everyone calls me Ed.

CHRIS: Hi, Ed. Nice to meet you.

ADAM: Ed's always in here. He's an Internet addict.

CHRIS: What are you doing?

ED: We're talking to a boy in Spain, a girl in Greece and another girl in Brazil.

ADAM: What about?

LUCY: Music - but none of us can agree on anything.

ED: Helena likes techno, José likes heavy metal and Maria, the Brazilian girl, prefers rap.

CHRIS: And what about you?

LUCY: We like pop.

CHRIS: Me too. Who's your favourite singer?

ED: Anjelika. She's cool!

CHRIS: Good choice. I've got both her albums at home.

LUCY: Where do you live?

CHRIS: Manchester.

ADAM: Let's send this e-mail to Michael.

ED: You can use this computer if you like.

ADAM: Great. Budge up.

LUCY: Hey!

CHRIS: I think we arrive in Boston tomorrow afternoon.

LUCY: You're leaving tomorrow? Does Sarah know?

ADAM: Not yet.

LUCY: Tomorrow's her eighteenth birthday.

ADAM: I know, but what can I do?

ED: She isn't going to like it.

ADAM: I know.

LUCY: You must tell her when she comes back from her driving lesson.

### EPISODE 2

#### SCRIPT

Scene 1

4:41 - 5:41

In Scene 1 Sarah gets back from her driving lesson and everyone decides to go to the cinema.

LUCY: What do you want to do this afternoon?

ED: Let's show Chris around London.

CHRIS: Sure.

ADAM: Sarah wants to go to the cinema. I think the film starts at 4.

LUCY: No problem. We can walk there and show Chris the sights on the way.

ED: Look, here's Sarah now.

LUCY: You mustn't laugh.

SARAH: Hello. Who's this?

CHRIS: I'm Chris.

SARAH: Aha! You're 17 and you're a student from Manchester, right?

CHRIS: How do you know?

SARAH: Adam tells me everything, don't you, Adam?

ADAM: All right, everyone, are you ready?

SARAH: Where are we going?

ADAM: To the cinema.

SARAH: Oh, right.

Scene 2

5:42 - 6:31

(Adam, Sarah, Chris, Ed and Lucy walk through London, looking at sights: Tower Bridge, River Thames, Trafalgar Square, Planet Hollywood.)

Scene 3

Adam tells Sarah he is leaving for America tomorrow.

6:32 - 7:07

ED: Are you doing anything special on your birthday, Sarah?

SARAH: That depends on you.

ADAM: Me?

SARAH: Yeah, or do you want to surprise me?

ADAM: No. I mean ... Yes. The thing is, Chris and I leave for America tomorrow morning.

SARAH: Are you serious? I don't believe it. That is just so typical of you.

ADAM: Please, just let me explain.

SARAH: There's nothing to explain. You're leaving on my birthday. My eighteenth birthday!

ADAM: Wait!

SARAH: Forget it, Adam. If that's all I mean to you, it's over. We're finished!

ADAM: Sarah!

## EPISODE 3

## SCRIPT

This episode opens with a view of semi-detached houses on a typical street in the UK. The camera pans to the house where Adam and Lucy live. We see Chris and Lucy putting bags in the boot of the car. The car belongs to Adam and Lucy's mother.

## Scene 1

7:13 - 9:09

CHRIS: I can't believe in 10 hours' time we're going to be in America!

LUCY: What time does the plane arrive in Boston?

CHRIS: About 25 past 1 in the afternoon.

LUCY: Is Michael going to meet you at the airport?

CHRIS: No, we're going to take a taxi to his house. It only takes half an hour.

LUCY: Oh, come on, Adam!

CHRIS: What's the matter?

ADAM: I'm waiting for Sarah. I don't want to leave without saying goodbye, not on her eighteenth birthday.

LUCY: Too bad. Mum's here now.

MRS SCOTT: Are you ready?

ADAM: Can we wait a few more minutes?

MRS SCOTT: No, we're late already.

ADAM: Go on, mum, please.

MRS SCOTT: No, it's time to go.

ADAM: OK.

MRS SCOTT: You have got some American money, haven't you?

ADAM: Not yet.

MRS SCOTT: Oh, Adam! How many times do I have to tell you?

ADAM: It's all right. I've got some traveller's cheques and I'll get some dollars at the airport.

MRS SCOTT: Don't forget to keep them in a safe place. You too, Chris.

ADAM: We know.

MRS SCOTT: What about your passport?

ADAM: It's in my bag.

MRS SCOTT: Tickets?

ADAM: Mum! Don't fuss!

MRS SCOTT: Well, you always forget something.

LUCY: Bye, Chris. Have an excellent time.

CHRIS: Bye, Lucy. Oh, and I will.

ADAM: Can you give this to Sarah?

LUCY: OK. Hurry up or you're going to miss the plane.

ADAM: Bye.

LUCY: Enjoy yourselves.

ADAM: You too.

## Scene 2

The second scene takes place in the Surf.net Café with Sarah looking distinctly unhappy. It's her birthday.

9:11 - 10:44

ED: Hey, cheer up. It's your birthday.

SARAH: What have I got to be happy about? My boyfriend's leaving for America and I'm stuck here all summer. All I've got to look forward to is my driving test.

LUCY: Happy birthday.

SARAH: Thanks.

LUCY: I hope you like it. I never know what to buy for you.

ED: Watch out. Here comes the boss.

SARAH: Tom? He's OK. Oh, a new bag! Thanks, Lucy. It's lovely.

TOM: What's this? A celebration?

ED: It's Sarah's birthday. She's 18 today.

TOM: Why don't you take the day off? You can't work on your birthday.

SARAH: Are you sure?

TOM: Of course. Let me buy you lunch before you go.

ED: What - all of us?

LUCY: Ed!

TOM: Go on then. It is a special occasion.

ED: Great. I'm starving.

TOM: What would you like?

ED: I'd like a potato with cheese and butter, and a tuna sandwich, please.

TOM: And for the birthday girl?

SARAH: I'd like a chicken and salad sandwich, please.

TOM: Is that all?

SARAH: Yes, thanks. I'm not very hungry.

TOM: Lucy?

LUCY: I'd like a sandwich too, please.

TOM: What sort would you like?

LUCY: What have you got for vegetarians today?

TOM: We've got egg, cheese and tomato, cheese and cucumber...

LUCY: Cheese and cucumber.

ED: Have you got any doughnuts?

TOM: Yes.

ED: Can I have one for pudding?

TOM: Would you like a drink?

ED: A glass of coke, please.

LUCY: I'd like a cup of coffee, with milk, please.

TOM: Sarah?

SARAH: No, thanks. I'm fine.

TOM: Coming right up!

LUCY: This is from Adam.

SARAH: Is it really?

ED: Aren't you going to open it?

SARAH: What's the point?

## EPISODE 4

## SCRIPT

The first scene of Episode 4 opens with a view of the street where Michael lives in the suburbs of Boston.

## Scene 1

11:02 - 11:50

MICHAEL: Hi there!

ADAM: Michael?

MICHAEL: That's me. You're Chris, right?

ADAM: That's Chris. I'm Adam.

MICHAEL: Nice to meet you guys at last. Are you tired after your trip?

ADAM: Not at all.

CHRIS: Neither am I.

MICHAEL: In that case, would you like me to show you around? Boston's a great city. There's lots to see.

ADAM: Sounds great!

MICHAEL: OK. Let's take your luggage inside. Then we can catch the 'T' into the city.

ADAM: The 'T'?

MICHAEL: The subway. Like the 'Tube' you have in London.

ADAM: Oh, right.

MICHAEL: I guess you guys have a lot to learn about America!

## Scene 2

11:51 - 12:51

{Michael, Adam and Chris walk around Boston, looking at the sights: a 'T' train, the Hancock Tower, the public garden and Boston Common, a Duck Tour bus, Fenway Park, Charles River, the Hard Rock Café}.

## Scene 3

This scene is in the Surf.net Café at the end of the day.

12:53 - 13:42

TOM: What are you doing here? Aren't you going out with your family tonight?

SARAH: Yes. I forgot this. I want to take it with me tonight.

TOM: That's old age for you! It makes you forget things.

SARAH: Cheeky!

TOM: This e-mail's for you.

SARAH: From Adam.

TOM: Aren't you going to read it?

SARAH: No.

TOM: Why not?

SARAH: Because I'm fed up with him. He always does exactly what he wants. He never thinks about me. Bye, Tom.

## Scene 4

This scene is back in Boston in an attic bedroom in Michael's house. Chris and Adam are getting ready for bed.

13:43 - 14:32

CHRIS: I can't wait to start camp next week. From what Michael says, it sounds fantastic. Adam?

ADAM: Hmm?

CHRIS: Are you still thinking about Sarah?

ADAM: She must have my e-mails by now. Is Michael still awake?  
 CHRIS: He's downstairs watching TV.  
 ADAM: I'm going to ask if I can send her another one.  
 CHRIS: Just forget about Sarah. It's over between you two, remember? This is the chance of a lifetime. You're supposed to be enjoying yourself. Why spoil it?  
 ADAM: OK. I promise not to mention her again.  
 CHRIS: That's more like it!

## EPISODE 5

### SCRIPT

#### Scene 1

14:38 - 15:18

(Some activities at summer camp: having breakfast, canoes, climbing.)

#### Scene 2

15:19 - 16:46

CHRIS: This place is great. There's so much to do.  
 MICHAEL: I know. I had some really good times here when I was a kid. I was always sad when summer vacation ended.  
 ADAM: Is that why you wanted to work here as a camp counsellor?  
 MICHAEL: It sure is. My uncle offered me a job in his store this summer, but I prefer being outdoors.  
 CHRIS: OK. What are we doing this morning?  
 MICHAEL: We're on sport duty. We're playing soccer with the kids.  
 CHRIS: Excellent!  
 ADAM: We call it 'football'.  
 MICHAEL: Really? Do you play?  
 CHRIS: Yes, all the time. It's my favourite game.  
 KIM: Hi, Michael.  
 MICHAEL: Kim! What are you doing here?  
 KIM: Didn't you know? I'm working here as a camp assistant.  
 MICHAEL: Kim, meet Adam and Chris. They're English. They're camp assistants too.  
 KIM: Hi. Nice to meet you.  
 ADAM: You too.  
 MICHAEL: Kim lives near me in Boston.  
 KIM: How do you like it here?  
 ADAM: I love it.  
 CHRIS: Yeah, Michael showed us round the city the other day.  
 KIM: What did you see?  
 ADAM: We went to the Boston Red Sox baseball ground.  
 KIM: Did he take you to the football stadium too?  
 ADAM: No, we didn't have time, but we're hoping to go another day. I love American football. I watch it all the time on TV back home.  
 KIM: You do?  
 ADAM: Yeah, I like the Chicago Bears.  
 KIM: Hey, you're in Boston now. You must support the New England Patriots.  
 ADAM: Yeah?  
 KIM: You bet! Let's go watch them play before you go back to England.  
 ADAM: Sounds great.  
 KIM: Are you guys on sport duty this morning?  
 ADAM: Yes.  
 KIM: Me too.  
 MICHAEL: Great. Let's go get the kids.  
 KIM: So tell me more about England ...

## EPISODE 6

SCRIPT In the first scene we see Lucy, Ed and Sarah in the Surf.n  
 Scene 1 Café.

16:52 - 17:58

SARAH: Whose is this? Is it yours?  
 LUCY: No, it's his.  
 ED: It's OK. You can take it. I've finished.  
 SARAH: Hey, Lucy, are your parents driving to Paris next week?  
 LUCY: No, they're going by train.  
 SARAH: So they're leaving their car at home?  
 LUCY: Yes. Why do you ask?  
 SARAH: Do you think I could borrow it?  
 LUCY: No way.  
 SARAH: Oh, please. I need to practise my driving.  
 LUCY: I'm sorry, but I can't let you.  
 SARAH: But I've got my test in a few weeks, and I'm really worried about it.  
 LUCY: What if something happens to the car?  
 SARAH: Nothing's going to happen, I promise.  
 ED: Who can go with you? I can't drive and neither can Lucy.  
 SARAH: That's not a problem. I can ask Tom.  
 LUCY: I don't know.  
 SARAH: Think about it. I can drive you wherever you want to go.  
 ED: Our very own taxi driver! Sounds great!  
 SARAH: You see! It'll be fun.  
 ED: Go on. We've got nothing else to do.  
 LUCY: Well ... OK then. As long as you promise to be careful.  
 SARAH: Yes! Thanks, Lucy. You're a real mate.  
 LUCY: I must be mad!

Scene 2 In this scene Michael, Adam, Chris and Kim have started their first morning's activity with the children at the summer camp.

17:59 - 19:52

MICHAEL: OK, kids, this morning we're playing soccer. Do you all know the rules?  
 CHILDREN: Yes.  
 MICHAEL: Chris and Adam are from Britain where soccer's the most popular sport. They're the experts, so if you have any questions, ask them. Chris is the captain of the red team, and Adam's the captain of the blue team. Karen, you be in Chris's team, and Kim, you be on Adam's team. Now, I'm the referee and I want you all to play fair. Is that clear?  
 CHILDREN: Yes.  
 MICHAEL: OK, everybody. Let's go!  
 CHRIS: Well done. You played really well.  
 MICHAEL: Who's ready for some lunch?  
 CHILDREN: Me!  
 MICHAEL: OK, kids. Follow me to the cafeteria. Could you 3 pick up this stuff and then catch up with us?  
 KIM: Sure.  
 ADAM: You played really well.  
 KIM: Thanks. I don't usually play soccer. I prefer hockey and basketball.  
 ADAM: Do you? I like tennis and cricket. Chris is the real football fan.  
 KIM: Which team do you like?  
 CHRIS: Man United, of course. Manchester is my home town.  
 ADAM: They're rubbish! Arsenal are the best.  
 CHRIS: They're useless. Don't listen to him.  
 ADAM: No, they're not.  
 KIM: Hey, cool it, guys. Let's put these things away and go have lunch.  
 ADAM: I'm right, you know.  
 CHRIS: Uh-uh. I'm right, you're wrong.  
 ADAM: Right!  
 CHRIS: Wrong! ...

Scene 3 This scene is back at the Surf.net Café. Sarah asks Tom if he will help her to practise her driving before her test.

19:53 - 20:11

SARAH: Hey, Tom, are you working on Friday?  
 TOM: No. I've got the day off.  
 SARAH: What are you doing?  
 TOM: Nothing much.  
 SARAH: In that case, could you do me a huge favour? Could you take me for a driving lesson in Lucy's mum's car?  
 TOM: OK. Why not.  
 SARAH: Excellent!

## EPISODE 7

### SCRIPT

Scene 1 This episode opens with Kim, Chris and Adam at the summer camp and a discussion about which activities each of them is going to do.

20:24 - 21:40

CHRIS: So what are we doing today?  
 ADAM: You're working down at the farm and I'm on water sport duty with Kim.  
 CHRIS: I hope I don't have to clean out the animal pens.  
 ADAM: Someone has to do it, but I'm glad it's not me. Hi, Kim.  
 KIM: Hi.  
 ADAM: You and I are on water sport duty.  
 KIM: Oh, no!  
 ADAM: What's wrong?  
 KIM: I've got a cold. I caught it this weekend while I was swimming.  
 ADAM: Oh, right.  
 KIM: What are you doing today?  
 CHRIS: I'm working down at the farm.  
 KIM: Can I swap duties with you?  
 CHRIS: Well ...  
 KIM: Please. I feel awful.  
 CHRIS: OK.  
 KIM: Thanks, Chris. I owe you one. What do they have down there, anyway?  
 CHRIS: Horses, cows, a few sheep ...  
 ADAM: And watch out for the big black dog! He chased me while I was walking past the other day. I thought he was going to bite me.  
 KIM: Thanks for the warning. How do I get there?  
 ADAM: Follow this path. Turn right opposite the dining hall. Go straight ahead and it's on your right. It's not far.  
 KIM: OK. See you later.  
 ADAM: Come on. Let's get down to the waterfront.

Scene 2 - This scene is at an indoor market.

21:41 - 22:27

SARAH: These earrings are pretty. I wonder how much they cost.  
 LUCY: 9 pounds 99. These are cheaper. They're 6 pounds 50.  
 SARAH: I bought some like that a few weeks ago. Have you got change for a 20 pound note? So did your parents leave for Paris this morning?  
 LUCY: Yes, they left straight after breakfast. Look what I've got!  
 SARAH: Yes!

Scene 3 - At Summer Camp

22:24 - 24:42

CHRIS: So we're supposed to be the kayak experts!  
 ADAM: Yeah, right! Do you understand this?  
 CHRIS: Just about.  
 ADAM: Can you explain it to the children while I fetch the life jackets?  
 CHRIS: I'll go and get them.  
 ADAM: It's OK. You stay here with the kids.  
 CHRIS: OK. Everyone pick up a paddle and gather round. Do you all know how to paddle a kayak? No?  
 WAYNE: I do. It's easy.

CHRIS: It may be easy for you, Wayne, but you're going to have to be patient while I explain it to the others. Now, the most important thing is ... balance. You mustn't lean too far to the left or to the right. Hold the ... Hold the paddle like this. No, Natalie. Like this. That's it. OK. Now, do you all know how to turn the kayak round in the water? No?

ADAM: Chris! Help him!  
 CHRIS: I can't!

SCRIPT The first scene shows Adam bringing Wayne safely back to shore.

Scene 1

24:45 - 25:14

ADAM: Are you OK? That was a very stupid thing you did. You nearly drowned. You must never go out in a boat without a life jacket again.

WAYNE: I'm sorry.

ADAM: Now go and get changed.

Scene 2

25:15 - 25:28

(Sarah, Tom and Lucy get into Lucy's mum's car. Sarah's driving lesson has turned into a shopping trip.)

Scene 3

25:29 - 26:33

(Sarah, Tom and Lucy enter a record shop. A man leaves a recording studio nearby, chased by a security guard.)

Scene 4 - At Summer Camp

26:34 - 27:16

CHRIS: I'm in big trouble.  
 ADAM: Why? What did Mr Cooper say?  
 CHRIS: He said I was stupid, irresponsible and wrong not to rescue Wayne when I saw he was having problems.  
 ADAM: You were just standing there, Chris.  
 CHRIS: You want to know why I didn't help him? It's because I can't swim, OK. I'm 17 and I still can't swim! Laugh if you want to. Everyone else does.  
 ADAM: I'm not laughing.  
 CHRIS: Mr Cooper's going to report me to the camp director. They're going to send me back to England, I know they are.

Scene 5 Sarah comes out of the music shop to find the car gone.

27:17 - 27:25

SARAH: Where's the car?

## SCRIPT

27:31 - 28:07

LUCY: What are we going to do about the car? I bet someone's stolen it.  
 TOM: Did you lock it?  
 SARAH: Of course I locked it. I'm sure I did. Oh, I think I left the keys in the car. I'm so sorry. This is all my fault.  
 LUCY: Sarah! What's my mum going to say?  
 SARAH: Maybe that woman took it.  
 TOM: Which woman?  
 SARAH: You know, the one I bumped into. She was wearing a red leather jacket. She was quite tall. She had long brown hair. And she was wearing glasses.  
 TOM: Hang on a minute. You can't start accusing people without proof.

## Scene 2

28:08 - 29:29

CHRIS: Why was I so stupid? Wayne nearly drowned out there because of me. The director's going to go mad.  
 MICHAEL: Hi, guys. What's up?  
 ADAM: We've got a problem. One of the kids we were looking after went out in a kayak on his own. It capsized and he wasn't wearing a life jacket.  
 MICHAEL: Is he all right?  
 ADAM: He's fine.  
 MICHAEL: So what's the problem?  
 ADAM: Chris saw the kid was in trouble, but didn't do anything to help.  
 MICHAEL: Why not?  
 CHRIS: Because I can't swim.  
 MICHAEL: Why on earth did you volunteer for water sport duty if you can't swim? That's the dumbest thing I've ever heard!  
 CHRIS: I didn't volunteer. Kim's got a cold, so she asked me to swap duties.  
 MICHAEL: Why didn't you tell her the truth?  
 CHRIS: I was too embarrassed.  
 MICHAEL: Hey, don't worry. I know plenty of people who can't swim. It's nothing to be ashamed of.  
 ADAM: Mr Cooper saw the whole thing. He's gone to tell the director.  
 MICHAEL: Mr Cooper! Uh-oh.  
 CHRIS: He's going to send me back to England, I know he is.  
 MICHAEL: Oh, boy! Let's go find Kim and get this straightened out.

 ED: What are you doing here? I thought you were having a driving lesson.  
 SARAH: I was ... until someone stole the car.  
 ED: You're joking! What are you going to do?  
 LUCY: Tell the police.  
 SARAH: Look, there it is!  
 TOM: Oil!

(Tom chases the car on Ed's bike.)

ADAM: At last! Well, what happened?  
 CHRIS: He was very angry, but he's decided to let me off. I can stay!  
 ADAM: All right!  
 MICHAEL: It wasn't all good news though, was it, Chris?  
 CHRIS: No. He told me to clean out the animal pens as a punishment.  
 ADAM: That's going to be smelly! Did the director say anything to you?  
 KIM: He said that if any of us want to swap duties in the future we must ask a staff member.  
 ADAM: That's fair enough.  
 KIM: What are you 2 doing this evening?  
 CHRIS: Nothing.  
 KIM: How about a trip to the mall to celebrate?  
 ADAM: Excellent! We haven't been to an American mall yet, have we, Chris?  
 CHRIS: What's it like?  
 KIM: It's really big, the biggest in the area.
